Since 2015 the Glennie Heights Scout Group have been assisting the HRCC with the Entry ticket sales at both Historic Race Meetings in early May and July each year.


Neil Meiklejohn (Emu) said the unexpected donation would go towards the renovation of the Scouts Den and thanked HRCC and its Members for the generous donation.

VALE: Robert Frederick 'Bob' JANE


The famous Racing Driver, Bob Jane, passed away peacefully on 28th September 2018, aged 88, surrounded by his family.
