

EX WHINCUP MONZA SPORTS SEDAN IS COMING TO HISTORIC QUEENSLAND.

Graeme Whincup, the uncle of Supercar champion Jamie Whincup, was a serious competitor in sports sedans during the 80's and campaigned a couple of Chev Monza's. In 1985 he built and raced his second car and it was quite something. After Whincup sold it on, it passed through a number of owners until Carey McMahon got hold of the car. Carey has an engineering background so a full strip back to bare shell was commenced so he could assess the scope of work needed to return the car to excellence. In doing so he got an appreciation of the unique suspension design that Ron Harrop had developed for the car. When it came to the engine, he discovered that the block had problems so the rebuild is all new from the heads down.

As can be seen in the photos, the rebuild is magnificent. Carey gave the Monza a run at the Mallala All Historic meeting back in April and is looking forward to competing in the Group U super sprint at Morgan Park.

Anniversary of 25th AGP at Lowood Event 25TH JULY, 2021 CASTROL the state of the second state of the



Summary of the HRCC Management Committee meeting held at the Mt Gravatt Showgrounds on Mon 7th June 2021.

- Membership Three new members since last report. Currently 494 total membership
- Treasurer report Financials remain on track with expectations.
- Motorsport Australia State Council nothing to report.
- Group Leaders Group Leader Forum arranged for 19th June at Carina Leages Club. Leaders requested to contact competitors for input of topics for discussion during conference. Display of cars at Repco stor arranged through Group Leaders
- Events Entry now open for Historic Queensland race meeting. Friday night HQ meet and greet to be arranged at Warwick golf club. Parking in pits and hiring of generators discussed. Budget for the meeting tabled. Discussed refunds for entrants who withdraw from the event. Criteria for timing of notice of withdrawal set.
- HRCC Clubhouse good response from submissions sought from HRCC membership. Has shown good support for a clubhouse. Interaction with Mt Gravatt Trust continues.
- HRCC 2020 Objectives Reviewed and progress being made to desired outcomes. Parts and service booklet info may need to be reworded to get more traction
- Trophy Presentation/Christmas to be held at Mt Gravatt Showgrounds using outside catering. Format of the event is still to be worked through. Potential for display cars. Catering arrangements discussed
- Social Meetings no progress on getting social meetings happening. Combination of Covid issues

and low member support is part of the problem.

- HRCC Library No discussion this meeting
- Scooter Donation no decision on what to do with it at this time.
- HRCC Constitution timeline laid out for progressing the review. First step is to gain HRCC member feedback on potential changes. Request for member input implemented with a 30th June cut off date. Plan is to formalise changes to the constitution for ratification at the 2021 AGM.
- Toowoomba Racerack No recent contact with developers. Has been reported that the submission for funding by the federal government has been rejected. Developers not responding to correspondence
- Regularity Competition Change to pointscoring resolved and to be detailed at Group Leaders Conference
- Regularity Pointscore System Need to improve the system to automate calculations to provide realtime results. Current system very labour intensive. MyLaps timing system seen as part of the problem. Discussions with MyLaps people and software developer are encouraging for a possible solution.
- Lowood Event 61st anniversary of the 25th AGP at Lowood on 25th July discussed and HRCC will help promote the event through commentary at HQ, the website and newsletter
- Committee Meeting minutes are available for members to view on request. Please contact the club secretary.
