HSRCA Spring Festival One Raceway – 26th & 27th September 2026

These Regulations are to be read carefully and in conjunction with the Supplementary Regulations as issued.

1. **Stewards for the Event** – Wayne Richards (Chair), Donna Willis, Evan Jones.
2. **Judge of Fact:**
Jess Nicholson, Liam Tame, Kate Eppelstun, Lisa Drayton and Rhys Swanson will be judge of fact for event starts and finishes.
Jess Nicholson, Liam Tame, Kate Eppelstun and Lisa Drayton for pit lane speed.
Jess Nicholson, Liam Tame, Kate Eppelstun for noise.
Rodney Bloomfield, Neris Bryden, Stephen King, Ben Rose, Glenn Nichols are judges of fact trackside.
Sam Keogh, Neil Tooke, Shannon Parnell, Rhianna Lyons, Kate Eppelstun and Rhys Swanson will be judge of fact for Pit Lane.
3. **Senior Officials** – Assistant Clerks of the Course – Tayla Flannery & Rohan Thatcher.
Chief Scrutineer – Bob Hockley.
4. **Grand Parade:** A Grand Parade, which will be conducted in accordance with the NCR will occur at Lunch Time on Saturday and Sunday.
5. **Handicap Race:** Group C&A will hold a handicap event for Race 17 on Sunday morning. The grid will be based on the results of Race 7, held on Saturday afternoon and will start in the normal manner. The handicap times for each driver will be determined by the C&A Handicapper and will be added post-race to determine the winner.
6. **Chief Medical Officer:** Dr Jessica Nathan.
7. **Private Practice:** Will be conducted on Friday 25th September 2026.

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8. **Formula Vee Qualifying and Race Format.** Formula Vee 1600 will have 3 x 20 minute qualifying sessions. Q4 will have all cars on track. Q9 will have the fastest 50% from Q4 and Q12 will have the slowest 50% from Q4. The grid for Race 1 will be determined from the fastest lap time from any of the qualifying sessions.

Formula Vee 1200 will have 2 x 20 minute qualifying session. Both sessions will have all cars on track. The grid for Race 1 will be determined from the fastest lap time from either qualifying session.

The grid for the Final (Race 4) for both classes will be determined from the maximum number of points scored for each competitor from the previous 3 races according to the table below:
